

SUBJECT: DNR Concerns per your emails from Monday April 26<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday April 27<sup>th</sup>.

Dear Chris:

Please be advised, we are in receipt of your communications as referenced in the subject line above. As a note of explanation, please allow us to offer the following:

- Our investigations have discovered that the persons who took the campers to the quarry and burned them were told to take them to the quarry and strip them, put what could be burned into a pile, and what needed to be disposed of in another pile. Obviously, that was not done. They burned them, and someone they know took their own bobcat and pushed the piles over. We are in contact with the homeowner's in question to determine a suitable course of action as outlined in your "Action Requirements".
- Additionally, Robert from WCA (our waste management provider ) will be meeting with trustees and maintenance on Saturday at 9am to advise how best to rectify this situation to the DNR's satisfaction.

The trustees at Bent Tree Harbor are respectfully requesting that you allow 90 days to get this resolved.
